


# <u>Time travel- An Adventurous Ride to Our Past &</u> <u>Future</u>

This year was no different from the rest. A variety of new programmes, various competitions and workshops were introduced to the students giving them all together a different learning experience.

We present to you our scientific report of the year 2019-20. Our scientific year



commenced with a lecture on the topic of '**DIGITAL SCANNING**'. It started with a short explanation on the topic explaining the uses and methods of digital scanning followed by a hands-on workshop where every intern was given a chance to try their bit on the new methods of digital dentistry. Not only were the students given a chance to try the intra-oral scanner but they were also explained the importance of each and every step.

One of the most awaited events every year has been the *World Dental Show* (WDS). We received an overwhelming response with respect to paper and poster presentations. Not only did MGM have maximum number of entries but we also bagged the maximum awards. There were about **110 entries** for poster and paper presentations combined! A special mention here to the first-year students who tried to give their best shot against their experienced seniors.



Our college has always aimed at giving the best learning experience to the students in every aspect possible, may it be clinical, cultural or sports which makes it so unique. Keeping that in mind, a CDE workshop was arranged by every department. One such workshop held in the month of December was on 'FORENSIC ODONTOLOGY' conducted by Dr Hemlata P. The importance of a set of 32 teeth in detection at a crime scene, discussing various case scenarios did give us the Sherlock feels. Who knew an oral cavity could solve a murder mystery?

It is said, 'suturing is a surgeon's skill'. To help us learn different suture techniques in a better way, a hands-on program on '**DIFFERENT SUTURING TECHNIQUES**' and lecture was organized by the Department of Oral Surgery under the guidance of **Dr Sunil Sidana**. This workshop not only helped us to learn different sutures but also to practise them, try it multiple times and correct our mistakes.

The constant efforts taken by our teachers to provide us and share with us every bit of knowledge that they have has been an important part of the education here at MGM. One such lecture organized by the department of **OMDR** was on "**CBCT TECHNIQUE**" conducted by **Dr Priyanka Tidke**.

# <u>Chasing Dreams</u>






