Detailed Report:

On the 15th of October,2016, the NSS Unit of MGM Dental College & Hospital, Kamothe, Navi Mumbai, in association with the Rotaract club of Dombivli Central, Rotaract club of Dombivli and Rotaract club of Panvel Midtown organised a road safety awareness program.

The program was also supported by the Young Inspirators Network group. The event was flagged off by an introductory speech by an NSS volunteer welcoming the dignitaries of the day Mr. Nandkishor Kadam, Assistant Police Inspector and Mr. Balasaheb Kale, Head Constable, of the traffic police department of Kalamboli. A seminar was held by one of the police officers talking about the importance of road safety and educating us about various traffic norms and regulations. This was followed by a presentation on road accidents by Mr. Abhishek Kumar a member of Young Inspirators Network. This presentation was followed by a question-answer session with the traffic police where the various volunteers were asking questions regarding efficacy and implementation of various traffic norms. After this session the volunteers gathered at Kalamboli Circle traffic police office and managed the traffic on the roads allotted to them for around forty minutes. This traffic management marked the end of the event and the volunteers experienced the life of a traffic police officer and were better educated about various traffic norms and regulations.
