NSS Unit of MGM Dental College invited Shri. Gajanan Kadam, Senior Police Inspector, Cyber Police Station, Navi Mumbai as a part of initiative to educate the public about the increasing threats in the digital world

Highlights of the Presentation:

1. Understanding Cybercrime:

Mr. Kadam began the session by defining cybercrime as any criminal activity that involves a computer, networked device, or a network. He emphasized how these crimes can be committed against individuals, property, or governments.

2. Types of Cybercrimes:

Various forms of cybercrimes were explained, including:

- Online frauds and scams
- Identity theft and phishing

- Cyberbullying and harassment
- Hacking and data breaches
- Ransomware and malware attacks
- Sharemarket fraud

3. Real-life Cases:

Mr. Kadam shared real-life cases and investigations handled by the cyber cell, highlighting the sophisticated methods used by cybercriminals and the importance of prompt reporting.

4. Legal Provisions and Penalties:

An overview of the Information Technology Act, 2000, and other relevant legal frameworks was provided. Mr. Kadam explained the punishments for various cyber offences and the procedures for filing complaints.

5. Preventive Measures:

Emphasis was placed on:

- Strong password management
- Avoiding suspicious emails and links
- Installing antivirus software
- Using secure Wi-Fi networks
- Regularly updating software and apps

6. Role of the Public:

Mr. Kadam stressed the importance of public awareness and collaboration in tackling cybercrime. He encouraged attendees to stay vigilant and report incidents without delay.

The session concluded with an interactive Q&A, where Mr. Kadam addressed concerns from the audience and shared contact details of the local cyber crime cell. The presentation was informative, engaging, and a vital step in spreading cyber safety awareness.
