Circular No. 90/2018

Passing of BDS Course within nine years including one year compulsory Rotatory Internship.

- Ref : 1) DCI's Revised BDS course Regulations 2007 dated 25th July 2007.
 - 2) University Examination Notification No.18/2013 dated 15/06/2013.
 - 3) Hon'ble High Court Order dated 03 March 2015 in W.P. No.9412 of 2014.
 - 4) Govt. of India, MHFW letter No. V/12012/04/2003-DE(pt) dated 27/01/2015.
 - 5) DCI's letter No. DE-87(1)-2014/14591 dated 09/02/2015.
 - 6) Amendment in DCI's Regulations 2007 dated 27th April 2015.
 - 7) Hon'ble High Court Order dated 06 March 2018 in W.P. Nos. 13510/2017, 13559/2017, 13607/2017, 11740/2017, 13509/2017.

In view of the above mentioned reference, Regulations and court orders of the Hon'ble High Court, it is notified as under;

1) The students who have been admitted from Academic Year 2008-09 to 2014-15 but not cleared their First Year within three years from the date of admission and the students who have admitted from the Academic Year 2015-16 and onwards should clear the BDS course in all subjects within a period of Nine years, including one-year compulsory Rotatory paid Internship from the date of admission.

It is mentioned in the amendment in DCI's Regulations 2007 dated 27th April 2015 that, "Any student, who does not clear the BDS course in all subjects within a period of Nine years, including one-year compulsory Rotatory paid internship from the date of admission shall be discharged from the Course."

2) However, the students admitted in the BDS course from Academic Year 2008-09 to 2014-15 but not cleared their First Year within three years from the date of admission and

the students who have been admitted from the Academic Year 2015-16 and onwards should pass the BDS course University examination as per details given below:

After passing the Final year University Examination of BDS course as per above schedule, it is mandatory for the students to complete their one year Rotatory Internship Training Programmme within the prescribed period of nine years.

- 3) It is observed that some students supposed to have been dischared from the course as they have not cleared their BDS course in all subjects within a period of Nine years, including-one-year compulsory Rotatory paid Internship from the date of admission have been appeared in Summer-2017, Winter-2017 and Summer-2018 examinations.
- 4) Subsequently, the above fact has been noticed by the University that the University has received exam forms of some students who have already completed duration of nine years for completion of BDS Course and their exam forms have been processed before commencement of Winter-2018 University examinations. However, these affected students are allowed to appear for the Winter-2018 examinations as a last opportunity and one time measure only and their results will be declared accordingly.
- 5) The Students who could not complete the BDS Course within a period of nine years are required to be discharged from the Course by the concern colleges and they will not be allowed to appear from the Summer-2019 onwards University examinations.

The Dean/Principal of the Colleges are therefore requested to verify their College records and inform all such students about the above criteria for BDS course prescribed by the Dental Council of India/ University. Admission of the student, who fail to clear BDS course within above

prescribed time-period, shall be cancelled by the College and information of the cancellation of admission shall be communicated to the University.

The Dean/Principal of the Colleges are hereby instructed to not to submit examination form of the students who have been dischared from the BDS course, from the Summer-2019 examinations.

In case of violation of the rules/ regulations prescribed by the Dental Council of India/ University, the Dean/ Principal of the College will be held responsible for further legal implications.

The Dean/Principal of the Colleges are requested to give wide publicity to this Circular at their College and the fact shall be brought to the notice of admitted students every year so as to avoid any legal complications at a later stage.
