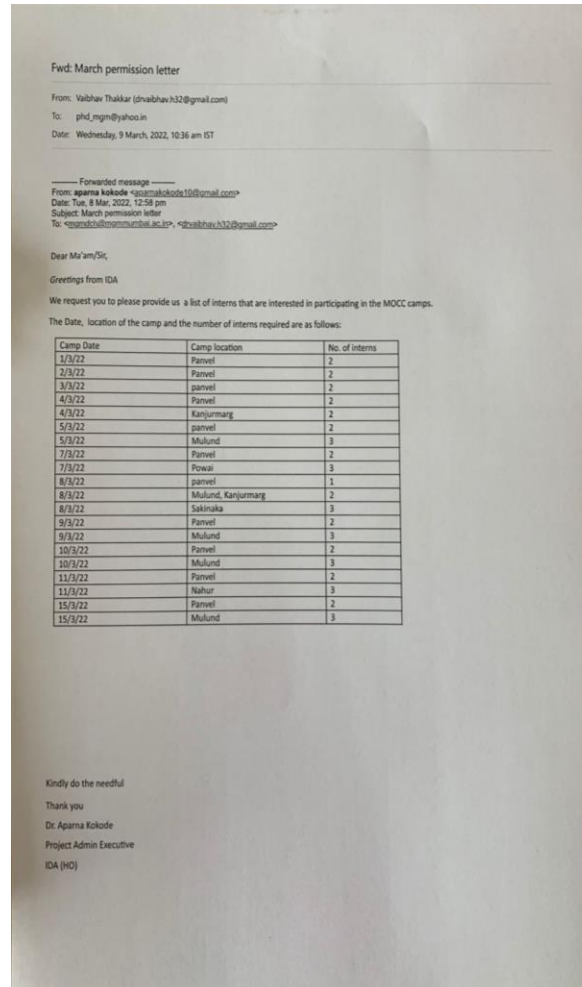

2. To educate them and create awareness about oral health.

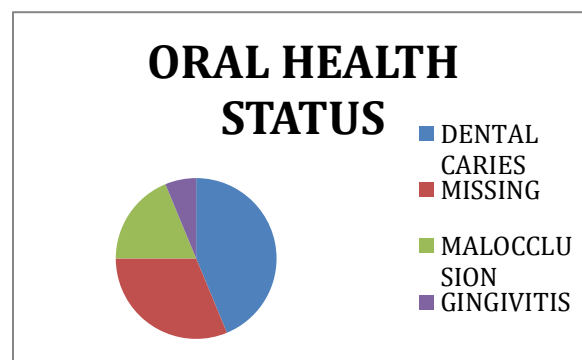
Method:

A type III examination was carried out with the use of mouth mirror and probe in day light. All the patients were assessed for oral health status and were explained the need to get the problems corrected. The patients were made aware of the existing dental problems and preventive measures were explained.

Observations: A total of **18** patients were examined for various dental problems. Those requiring extensive treatment were referred to MGM Dental College and Hospital, Kamothe.

Oral health status:

Condition	No. of individuals	Percentage %
Dental caries	9	50 %
Gingivitis	6	33.33 %
Missing	2	11.1 %
Malocclusion	1	5.6 %



Interpretation and conclusion:

Dental caries is the most common problem among the patients followed by gingivitis.

Oral health education and prevention strategies should be implemented in order to reduce the disease burden among these patients.
